## Application Process for Family & Carer Committee Membership

Expressions of interest must include an up to date resume, as well as addressing the essential and desirable criteria documented on the position description included, ie;

## **Essential Qualifications and Experience:**

- Experience as a parent and / or carer of a young person aged 12-25 who have been considered to have a mental illness or a diagnosis of a mental illness.
- Currently living in the Newcastle region.
- Demonstrated enthusiasm regarding young people, the local community, and youth mental health in particular and also possess an understanding of "early intervention" principles.
- Nominees should be available to attend at least 3 meetings per year in person, and commit to the sub-committee for a period of 12 months at least.

## **Desirable Qualifications, Education and Experience:**

- Ability to use initiative to identify areas for improvement and implement changes.
- Diploma in Youth Work, Community Services, or the equivalent combination of relevant qualification and experience, or currently undertaking same.
- Evidence of further training such as Certificate IV in Mental Health or Drug and Alcohol.
- Understanding of the issues and barriers for parents, families, friends, and carers in accessing mental health services.
- Experience in working with youth from Aboriginal and/or CALD cultures.

Applicants should be aware that a clear working with children check and a criminal clearance is required to be successful.
