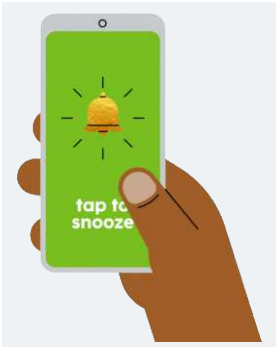
What is the Youth Health Clinic?
