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## **Mental Health Week Art Competition 2018**

## **Terms & Conditions:**

- 1. **Entrance Fee:** There is no entry fee.
- 2. Age and artwork: Entry is open to artists aged 12-25 years old ONLY. Artwork entries must be the original work of the artist. Entries must be two dimensional art pieces, including but not limited to; drawing, painting, photography and digital design. Artwork must be capable of being hung for exhibition. Each artist may submit no more than two pieces.
- 3. Entry forms: All works must be accompanied by a completed entry form which includes; the title of the work, the artist's name and date of birth, contact details and a brief explanation about how the work relates to the competition theme.
- **4. Size:** Each piece submitted must be no larger than 120cm by 120cm
- 5. Delivery: Artworks, together with the entry form, must be mailed\* or delivered to headspace, Level 2, 42 Grafton St, Cairns QLD 4870 by 5pm, Friday 2 November 2018. \*Entrants who mail their artwork must make appropriate arrangements to protect their artwork in transit. No liability will be assumed by headspace Cairns for artworks damaged in transit.
- 6. Clear Label: Artworks must be clearly marked on the back with the entrant's name, address, telephone number and email address
- 7. Unacceptable Artwork: Artwork deemed inappropriate or offensive by headspace Cairns management will be removed from competition and not considered for judging.
- 8. Damage: Whilst headspace Cairns will take all possible care, no responsibility will be taken for damage which may occur while the artwork is with headspace Cairns. To avoid damage to your artwork:
  - Ensure your artwork is dry before submitting it to the competition;
  - You may wish to frame your artwork for its protection.

- Closing date: All artworks and completed entry form must be delivered to headspace Cairns by 5pm Friday 2 November 2018. Entries received after this time will not be accepted.
- **10. Judging:** Judging will take place during the week following the closing date. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- **11. Winners:** Winners will be notified on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2018.
- 12. Public Exhibition: An exhibition of works will take place on Social media and in the Centre. All entrants, family, friends and fellow artists are encouraged along with the general public to attend and to vote for the People's Choice award. If entrant chooses to donate the artwork to headspace Cairns then they will remain on display at the centre.
- **13. Collection:** All artwork not being donated to headspace Cairns must be collected by 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018.
- 14. Uncollected Artwork: It is not the responsibility of the event organisers to return works to entrants. If artwork is not collected by the above date it will be discarded.
- **15. Photography: headspace** Cairns shall have the right to photograph artworks and publish those photographs for publicity purposes.
