

Rainbow Mates

Rainbow Mates is a group aimed at young females who are bisexual/same-sex attracted or are questioning their sexuality, and young people who identify as transgender or gender diverse between the ages of 12-25.

The group meets in Salisbury at Twelve25 Youth Enterprise Centre on a fortnightly basis afterhours. A light dinner is also provided with refreshments. The purpose of the group is to provide young people with a safe and respectful place to explore and express their identity free from judgment and stigma. The content is driven by the needs of the participants which can include areas such as guest speakers discussing various health related topics, community event planning, discussing current events and media content as well as providing a generalised supportive environment and relaxed atmosphere.

Position available -Research Assistant



The Northern Health Network (headspace Edinburgh North) is excited to announce that it has partnered with Orygen – The National Centre of Excellence in Youth Mental Health in a groundbreaking research study. The IMPACT Youth Study (Improving Mood with Physical ACTivity) aims to investigate whether physical activity helps with treating symptoms of depression in young people. The current recommended treatments for depression in young people, such as cognitive behavioural therapy, have been shown to reduce symptoms of depression and/or lead to recovery from depression.

However, improvements to the effectiveness of such treatments can be made and it is considered important to examine additional treatment strategies in order to provide better outcomes for young people. One such strategy that has an emerging evidence-base is physical activity as an augmentation or adjunct treatment (that is, adding physical activity to usual treatment). The project will involve participants receiving the treatment that they would usually receive when coming to the headspace centre. In addition, clinicians that choose to take part in the project will be randomized to provide either the brief physical activity intervention or lifestyle information. The physical activity intervention is considered the "active" treatment as this is the intervention we are most interested in investigating. The lifestyle information is considered the "control" treatment, as it is being used as a comparison treatment. A total of 960 young people will participate in this project. The research has been funded through a National Health & Medical Research Council project grant. The project has been approved by the Human Research Ethics Committee of the University of Melbourne.

As part of the forthcoming roll-out of the study, NHN is currently recruiting for a Research Assistant to join the dynamic multi-disciplinary headspace Edinburgh North team and to be the lead researcher in this study.
