1.We are an inclusive and respectful group. No slurs, excessive swearing, deadnaming, homophobia, biphobia, transphobia, body shaming, judgement of others, or violations of other's individual rights.

2.Keep conversations family friendly, we must be mindful of the different ages in the group.

3.Be mindful of others sensory needs, limit yelling and be respectful when people communicate their needs.

4.Try our best to wear badges with names and pronouns to help each other out. Create a badge at first session or when preferences change and leave at The Brocas at the end of the session.

5.If incorrect names or pronouns are used, correct with respect, we all make mistakes. If someone continues to not respect your preferences, let Kat or Aisha know.

6.Be inclusive of new members, encourage introductions and invite them into activities/games with the group.

7.Check in when you arrive and when you are leaving.

8. There is no expectation for you to participate in activities, be involved in whatever you are comfortable with.

9.This is a space to make new friends and have fun. Physical contact and dating is not encouraged due to the differences in ages.

10.If photos are taken, they must only be of activities, no showing other people.

11. You're responsible for your own equipment, etc.

12.We are a strict Substance free zone – no drugs, alcohol, vaping.
